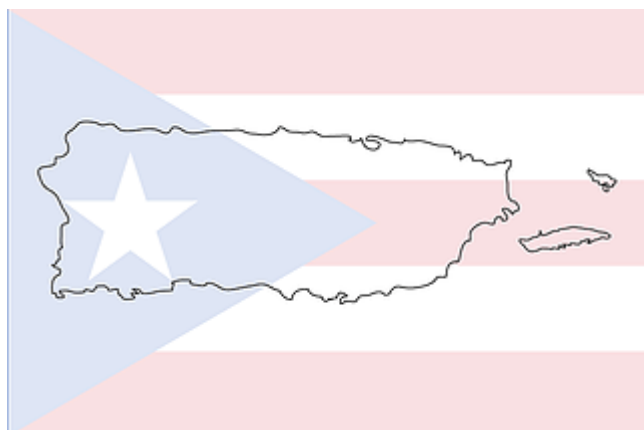


OGE HURRICANE RELIEF DRIVE FOR TAR HEEL FAMILIES in VIRGIN ISLANDS and PUERTO RICO
