

## Student-Supervisor Wrap-up

The Student-supervisor wrap-up is an opportunity for students and supervisors to reflect on the student's service-learning experience together.

Begin by scheduling a 30-minute meeting at the end of semester. Staff members who worked closely with the student are ideal additions. This conversation can help students gain a better sense of their capabilities in conducting service and share thoughts on their service experience. In addition, supervisors can feel better equipped to evaluate their student performance and see the organization from a volunteer's perspective.
